



Bridal Emergency Kit List

Brides should always be prepared at her wedding for any type of emergency on your big day, so please keep your bridal emergency kit in the dressing room, and make an additional bridal emergency kit for the maid of honor. Please be sure that these bridal emergency kits travel to locations, such as the reception hall. For easy functional purposes, place these items in tote bag or organizer type of cosmetic bag. Pick up your essential supplies at your local CVS or Walgreens. Most items you can find in the travel size department of the store. Here is a list of suggested items to include in the bride's emergency kit.

Grooming

- hand lotion
- tissues
- cotton balls and q-tips
- makeup

- clear nail polish
- nail polish remover
- nail file
- tweezers
- small grooming scissors
- small hand towel
- hard candy, mints, or Listerine strips
- lint brush
- curling iron or hot rollers
- hair dryer
- brush and comb
- hairspray
- bobby pins, hair elastics, barrettes
- headband or clips
- toothbrush, toothpaste, floss and mouthwash
- mirror
- baby powder
- deodorant
- perfume
- tissues or handkerchief
- wet wipes

Attire

- "throwaway" garter
- clear nail polish
- extra earring backs
- extra buttons
- flat shoes for the reception
- safety pins and extra buttons
- extra pantyhose
- jewelry
- spot remover
- safety pins
- masking tape or sewing tape
- small scissors (for thread)
- club soda or other stain removal solutions
- iron
- mini sewing kit (matching threads)
- scotch tape
- iron
- hem tape

Health

- antacid
- antihistamine
- aspirin or tylenol
- eye drops
- bandages
- upset stomach medicine (antacid)
- feminine hygiene products (tampons, panty liners, pads)
- dental floss

Miscellaneous

- extra copies of directions to reception
- breath mints
- cell phone and home phone numbers wedding party
- contact information for all vendors and cell phone
- snacks
- small flashlight
- utility knife
- duct tape
- water (and mini cooler if you have one)
