

When using candles we need to remember to use candle safety and precautions, which means you need watch them carefully and please do not leave your candles unattended. WicksnCandlesticks would like you to enjoy your candles, while utilizing candle safety and precautions. Follow these simple rules mentioned below to ensure candle safety in your home or business.

Candle Safety:

- Maintain a candle in a viewing distance or sight.
- Extinguish your candle before you go to bed or when you leave a room.
- Never burn a candle on or near anything that can catch fire or anything flammable.
- Always remember to trim your candlewicks at least a ¼ of an inch before you light your candle.
- Please keep candles out of reach of children and pets.
- Always burn candles on a place that is flat, stable, sturdy, and heat-resistant surface.
- A candle should be on a large enough item to contain drips or melted wax.
- Maintain your candlestick trimming and keep your candle free from matches and debris at all times.
- Do not burn candles longer than recommended.
- Always keep candles away from drafts, vents, ceiling fans or any air currents where they could catch fire.
- Always burn candles in a room that is well-ventilated area.
- Do not burn candles until there is almost no candle wax left from the candles.
- Extinguish a candle flame before it gets too close to the candleholder or container, which is approximately 2 inches of wax.
- Never touch candles when burning or move a candle or container when the wax is in a liquid form.
- Never use a sharp object to remove candle wax from a candleholder, container, or glass plate.
- When burning candles separate each candles at least three inches apart from other candles.
- When extinguishing a candle use a candlesnuffer to prevent wax from spillage.
- Do not extinguish a candle with water.
- If you choose to light a candle during power outages, use candles very carefully if you decide to light them.
- If your candles are smoking, flickering, or there is a high flame, extinguish the candle.
- Never use a candle as a bed time night light.

Here are some simple rules for Candle Care to keep your candles looking beautiful while they burn.

Candle Care:

- Always remember to store your candles in a cool, dark, and dry place.
- When storing taper candles be sure to place them flat and solid surface to prevent warping to the candle.
- To clean and remove dust or fingerprints from candles use a lightly dampened soft cloth or soft piece of nylon.
- When removing wax drippings from candleholders, you can place the candleholders over hot

- running water.
- Always remember never to use a knife or sharp object to remove wax drippings from glass holders or containers, because it will either scratch the glass or cause it to break.
 - Always use candle accessories such as glass plates or glass candleholders because these items were specifically designed to withstand various temperature changes while burning candles.
 - Do not use everyday glassware for burning candles.
 - Always burn candles on a place that is flat, stable, sturdy, and heat resistant surface.
